

## **Philosophers for Sustainability**

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### **Activities in 2019**

- **Grew from 0 members to 88 and counting**, now in 14 countries. (Our initial goal was 80 members within three years.)
- **Wrote guidelines** for sustainable practices in philosophy, which we own and can use in advocacy worldwide, with contributions from about 30 members and many non-members.
- Built a relationship with the American Philosophical Association, who just awarded us a grant and is considering adding our guidelines to its Good Practices Guide.
- Built an active **social media presence**.
- Started and ran an ongoing series of **monthly video forums**, on topics from advocacy to teaching to resource gathering to public philosophy.
- Formed smaller **advocacy teams** focused on climate strikes, teaching, public philosophy, resource gathering, e-conferencing, and public philosophy.

### **Our goals for 2020**

- 1) Continue to grow an active global membership, video forum series, social media presence, and a presence at large philosophy conferences.
- 2) Take an active role in supporting climate strikes, teaching efforts, on-campus advocacy, and public philosophy related to climate change.
- 3) Collect and share useful resources for philosophers interested on working toward sustainability in practice.
- 4) Put on an e-conference and collect contributions toward an edited volume.
- 5) Support a wide range of efforts by our members and help put people in touch with each other.
- 6) Begin to form local teams who can work together in person on a range of sustainability efforts.
