

## Default Question Block

The department is considering integrating one or more Zoom Colloquia into the Colloquium schedule for the next academic year. We are particularly moved by two considerations:

- 1) This will increase diversity, allowing us to invite speakers from universities outside of North America, which would otherwise be out of budget (e.g. universities in East and South Asia).
